Dear Friends,

Each year more than 10,000 women join construction teams during **The National Women Build**, raising their hammers to help build affordable housing in their own communities. This April, we here at **Habitat for Humanity Williamson-Maury** (HFHWM) will kick off our 10th Annual Women Build and will hold our largest fundraiser, **Hammers & High Heels**, on June 1 to raise money to build this home.

More than **300 volunteers**, 70% of them women, will come together over seven weeks to build alongside a family in need of affordable housing. Volunteers will put in **2,400+ labor hours** to make the dream of homeownership a reality for our 2019 Women Build family, The Herrera Family. Maria Herrera cares for her 72-year-old mother Estella and her 16-year-old son Abraham.

Maria is overwhelmed with gratitude, often to the point of tears. “We are so thankful for this opportunity. It is a blessing to have the community gather together to help our family. My hope is that my home will extend beyond blessing only my family and that it will become a blessing for others as well.” Over the next few months, she will complete 280 hours of “sweat equity,” save \$2000 in closing costs, and will then be eligible to purchase her house with a **zero-interest mortgage**.

Our annual **Hammers & High Heels** event, which brings together 350+ attendees to raise funds for the home, will be held on **Saturday, June 1, 2019 at The Marriott in Franklin, TN**. Our goal for 2019 is to raise the **\$70,000** needed for the “bricks and sticks” of this home. We need your help!

We ask that you consider being part of this incredible event by donating an item or service valued at \$100 or more. The auction is online about a week prior of the event for maximum exposure for our donors. We will share your kindness by posting it on our Facebook, Twitter, newsletter (to 6,000 +), and on the event’s mobile app (which also includes a link to your website).
