TRIP ITINERARY

Saturday, Nov. 9

Arrive at La Aurora International Airport (GUA) where the team is greeted by HFH staff and transported to a nearby hotel.

Sunday, Nov. 10

Travel two hours to Tecpán for orientation where the team meets partner families and learns about project details and cultural norms.

Monday, Nov. 11 to Friday, Nov. 15

Build on site with evenings free to explore local sights and a cultural activities. Wednesday may include visiting a local weaving cooperative or Mayan Ruins.

Saturday, Nov. 16

Return to Antigua to take a historical walking tour or hike a volcano (complete with lava roasted marshmallows).

Sunday, Nov. 17

Team members return home.

Meals and accommodations
